A very special "Thank You" to all who donated to Madison County Right to Life in memory of Bill Wason. Bill was a board member for 20+ years. After much prayerful thought and research, the board decided to use the money to purchase a bench in his memory.

Abortion in Kentucky

On June 24, 2022 the US Supreme Court overturned the 1973 Roe v Wade decision that had legalized abortion. Once this happened, Kentucky's Life Protecting Law of 1906 went into effect making us an abortion-free state. Immediately law suits were filed by pro-abortion forces. Fortunately, their attempts failed.

Even though physical abortions are no longer being performed here, we are not truly abortion-free. In April 2021, the Biden administration's FDA stopped requiring that abortion drugs be dispensed to women in person, which allowed them to receive abortion pills through the mail with telehealth appointments. The FDA has not enforced the in-person dispensing requirement ever since.

Mifepristone has become the most common abortion method. More than two-thirds of abortions nationwide are caused by this abortion pill. Shield laws allow abortionists to mail abortion drugs to women in states that prohibit most abortions (like Kentucky) or impose gestational limits on abortions, promising them immunity from lawsuits or state penalties. **Women in Kentucky are able to order and receive this abortion pill through the mail.**

The Food and Drug Administration's rules are being challenged by Louisiana Attorney General Liz Murrill. The challenge argues that mail-order delivery of Mifepristone undermines state abortion bans and pro-life laws. It also endangers women due to the significant harm that the drug causes them. Recently, the Supreme Court decided to temporarily allow access to the abortion death pill by mail.

A new report from the pro-abortion Guttmacher Institute estimates that more than 1.12 million babies were killed in abortions in the US in 2025. That equates to more than 3,000 unborn children losing their lives each day!
